## THREE CATEGORIES OF SRAE PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- 1. Structure, cost, and support for program implementation (submitted annually)
- 2. Attendance, reach, and dosage (submitted biannually)
- 3. Participant characteristics, program experiences, and perceptions of program effects (submitted biannually)

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# **KEY DEFINITIONS**

- Grant recipients are organizations that receive SRAE funding directly from FYSB
- Providers are organizations that provide SRAE programming directly to youth
  - Some providers are SRAE grant recipients
    - o Others are subrecipients that receive funding through an SRAE grant recipient
- Program models consist of core curriculum plus other lessons or activities integrated to meet SRAE objectives
- Cohorts are groups of youth jointly receiving a defined SRAE program
  - o A cohort could consist of an individual, if programming is delivered one-on-one



#### SRAE PERFORMANCE MEASURES DASHBOARD

- The dashboard provides reports and visual representations of the performance measures data
- The dashboard is updated biannually
  - When the most recent data available are from a winter submission, the dashboard shows that half year of data
  - When additional data are submitted the following summer, they are combined with the first half of the data to create a full year, replacing the half year



#### DASHBOARD ACCESS AND PRIVACY

- Users have customized Dashboard experiences based on their role
  - Grant recipients can only view data for their own grants, providers, and programs
  - $\circ\,$  Providers can only view their own data and their programs' data
- Only SRAE grantees recipients, their partners, and ACF staff and contractors can have accounts
- Data are housed on Amazon Web Services in a FedRAMP-compliant environment
- Multi Factor Authorization is utilized to keep accounts secure
- Small sample sizes (10 or less) are suppressed to maintain data privacy

#### **WELCOME TO SRAE PAS**

Sexual Risk Avoidance Education (SRAE) programs seek to prevent negative outcomes that could have lasting effects on a young person's health, future career prospects, and economic stability.

The Performance Analysis Study (PAS) collects program data from SRAE grantees on performance measures. These measures allow for an assessment of whether grant objectives are being met. This site provides a platform for SRAE grantees to access tools and training resources related to the study.
